## **Registration Fees**

The entry fee is \$75 for single-handed boats and \$95 for double-handed boats. Please add \$15 late fee after May 15<sup>th</sup>. Registration will close Friday, May 28 at 1700. There will be no on-site registration. The entry fee includes regatta pack with T-shirt, continental breakfast and lunch both days, dinner on Saturday, and ice cream sundaes on Sunday.

## **Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the rules of The International Optimist Dingy Assoc., the Laser Class Assoc., or the Club 420 Class Association as appropriate to the fleet and the Notice of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions. The organizing authority is the Davis Island Yacht Club. This is a Category "A" event in accordance with RRS Appendix 1, ISAF Regulation 20.

## **Eligibility and Entry**

All Optimist competitors must have been born on or after January 1, 1995. The Optimist Green Fleet is open to any beginning Optimist sailor who meets the criteria specified by USODA. USODA membership is required for RWB Opti competitors. The C420, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7 and other fleets are open to any competitors. Competitors must have completed all parts of the entry form prior to the close of onsite check-in.

## **Risk**

Parents/guardians are responsible for the safety of each sailor under 18 years of age. This means that they must make the decision whether or not their sailor(s) can handle the conditions at the beginning of each day. Once afloat, each competitor will accept responsibility and decide whether he/she is able to continue racing if conditions deteriorate. The competitor will accept full responsibility for his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during and after the regatta.

## **Racing**

All classes will race in Hillsborough Bay south of DIYC.

## **Scoring**

The Low Point System, RRS Appendix A2, shall apply, modified such that no score shall be discarded until 6 or more races are completed, at such time the competitor's worst eligible score shall be excluded from the series total.

## **Facility Consideration**

Food and beverages will be available at the club. The pool will be available for use with a lifeguard on duty. Children must be attended at all times by a designated adult on premise. Area accommodations are available for quests. Camping at Davis Island Yacht Club is very limited (first come first serve) and a waiver and liability form must be completed by adults on site. All campers must have adult supervision and must have prior approval of club manager and regatta chairperson. NO pets on club property.
